



ARTZI: THE ARTISTIC ISRAEL GAP YEAR PROGRAM

Are you **creative**? Do you have **LEADERSHIP** qualities? Do you want to experience something *different* and *unique* before you start college? Check out **Artzi**!

Artzi is a 9-month program in the heart of Jerusalem that combines the Israel experience, the arts and Judaism in one amazing year of self-discovery, connection and fun!

ISRAEL

At Artzi, students don't just live *in* Israel, they get to *live* Israel. Artzi students live with, hike with, learn with and volunteer with students from the Israeli, artistic pre-army training program, Ruach Nachon. Once a month, we embark on three-day hiking trips throughout Israel. Once a week, the students engage in group volunteer work in our campus community, as well as individual volunteer work that is fitting to each particular student. Our students have the option of joining some of the Ruach Nachon courses as well, such as: training workouts, krav maga self-defense, meditative yoga, and more! By the end of the year, Artzi students will be able to speak and understand Hebrew on a high level, have developed long-lasting friendships with Israelis their age and will have experienced Israel on a totally different level than ever before.

ART

Students get to choose from four art tracks: **Visual Arts**, *Music*, **Theater** and **Dance**. Each week, students get one-on-one studio time to work with professional artists on their personal project, as well as time for group sessions and trips to museums, galleries and performances. Artzi is for students who want to come to Israel to have an amazing year of self-discovery, a high level of learning and amazing hiking and volunteering, but don't want their artistic talents to sit and wait on the sidelines all year long. Not only does our program enable all of that, but our students will also learn leadership through the arts, and take those lessons back to the States with them.

JUDAISM

Artzi is co-ed and pluralistic, allowing our students to learn in an open environment and really challenge themselves to fully reach their potential. On a week, when our students are on campus and not traveling, students spend their mornings delving into their Jewish heritage in a pluralistic academic environment. This type of environment encourages textual analysis through free and open discussion. The talented staff and teachers at Artzi help each and every student on their journeys of self-discovery, spiritual growth and meaningful connection to the Jewish nation and heritage.
